WHEREAS, the National Marine Fisheries Services will conduct a hearing concerning THE PROPOSED REGULATIONS TO GOVERN THE INCIDENTAL TAKE OF MARINE MAMMALS IN THE COURSE OF PURSE SEINE FISHING OPERATIONS FOR YELLOWFIN TUNA; and

WHEREAS, said hearing is presently scheduled to be held in Washington, D. C. beginning November 15, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the tuna industry most affected by these proposed regulations is located in California and not Washington, D. C.; and


WHEREAS, the people directly involved in California should be given the opportunity to voice their views and have the bureaucracy in Washington, D. C. come to the people; and

WHEREAS, this can be accomplished only by rescheduling the situs of the hearings from Washington, D. C. to San Diego, California on the designated date; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of the City of San Diego and those most directly involved in the tuna industry, does hereby request and petition the Director of the National Marine Fisheries Services to renote and reschedule the hearing concerning THE PROPOSED REGULATIONS TO GOVERN THE INCIDENTAL TAKE OF MARINE MAMMALS IN THE COURSE OF PURSE SEINE FISHING OPERATIONS FOR YELLOWFIN TUNA beginning November 15, 1976 from Washington, D. C. to a location in San Diego, California, so that

those persons most directly involved in the tuna industry and affected by such regulations may have an opportunity to voice their views in an open, available and democratic process.
