RESOLUTION OF INTENTION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MARKET STREET LIGHTING DISTRICT AND TO ANNEX SAID DISTRICT INTO THE SAN DIEGO STREET LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 65.0201 et seq. of the San
Diego Municipal Code and Section 22500 et seq. of the California
Streets and Highways Code, The City of San Diego proposed the
formation of the Market Street Lighting District and the annexation of the district into the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance
District No. 1; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer's Report, including a map incorporated therein, as required by Section 65.0217 (3) of the San Diego Municipal Code has been considered and approved and filed with the City Clerk as Document No. _____; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the public interest, convenience and necessity require and it is the intention of this Council to order the formation and establishment of a maintenance district pursuant to the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975 (commencing with Section 65.0201 et seq. of the San Diego Municipal Code) for the maintenance of public facilities within the boundaries of the district to be known as the MARKET STREET LIGHTING DISTRICT. The maintenance shall include, but is not

limited to the supplying of energy to street lights, replacement of lamps and glassware, and periodic cleaning and painting of standards.

- 2. The subject property to be maintained shall be designated as such in the above referenced Engineer's Report (including the map therein) on file in the office of the City Clerk, which report provides a full and detailed description of the improvements, the boundaries of the assessment district and any zones therein, and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the district.
- 3. The contemplated maintenance is, in the opinion of the Council, of more than local, ordinary public benefit, and the expenses of such maintenance should be made chargeable upon the district herein described, and the Council does declare said district to be the district benefited by the maintenance.
 - 4. The proposed district is generally described as follows:

The abutting property and right-of-way of Market Street, between 41st Street and Denby Street, as shown on the map on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 757132 , and also page 150 of maps for the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1.

- 5. It is proposed that the maintenance shall be performed from the date of the formation of the district until June 30, 1977.
- 6. Notice is hereby given that JAN 5 1977, at 2;00 p.m., in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, The Charles C. Dail Concourse, in the

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City of San Diego, California, are the day, hour and place for the hearing when and where any and all persons having any objection or protest to the proposed maintenance or to the extent of the district to be assessed, may appear and show cause why the proposed maintenance should not be carried out in accordance with this resolution of intention; failure to make objections at this time shall be deemed to be a waiver of all objections and shall operate as a bar for any and all claims.

Such protest, if any, must be in writing and must contain a description of the property in which each signer thereof is interested sufficient to identify the same and shall be delivered to and filed with the City Clerk at a time not later than the hour set for the hearing.

- 7. The assessments, if any, will be levied pursuant to the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975.
- 8. That the City Clerk is directed to cause this resolution or a notice thereof to be published once at least fifteen (15) days before the date of the hearing in the City Official Newspaper.
- 9. The City Clerk is directed to mail copies of this resolution or notices thereof, postage prepaid, to all persons owning real property proposed to be assessed whose names and addresses appear on the last equalized County assessment roll.

MICROFILMED MAY 3 0 1978 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of The City of San Diego to further consider the annexation of the Market Street Lighting District into the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 and to declare such annexation if such annexation is deemed appropriate at the conclusion of the public hearing.
