

RESOLUTION NO. 217297

DEC 21 1976

WHEREAS, Section 131 of the Charter of The City of San Diego provides mandatorily for forfeiture of right to employment of any person who knowingly makes a false statement in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to make provision for some exercise of administrative discretion in that regard in lieu of the present foreclosure of any administrative discretionary determination; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That it is the desire and intention of this Council to place before the voters of the City of San Diego at the September, 1977 election a ballot proposition to amend Section 131 of the Charter to allow some administrative discretion in dealing with false information on applications for employment.

Section 131. FALSE STATEMENT BY APPLICANT.

Any applicant for any office or employment in the classified service who shall knowingly make any false statement deemed material to eligibility for the position sought in connection with any test shall thereby forfeit his right to be entered upon the eligible register, and in case he has been appointed to an office or employment he shall forfeit it and may not be entitled for a period up to three years thereafter, within the discretion of and until notified by the Civil Service Commission, to take any Civil Service test or be eligible for appointment to any office or employment in the service of the City.

Section 131. FALSE STATEMENT BY APPLICANT.

Any applicant for any office or employment in the classified service who shall knowingly make any false statement deemed material to eligibility for the position sought in connection with any test shall thereby forfeit his right to be entered upon the eligible register, and in case he has been appointed to an office or employment he shall forfeit it and ~~shall~~ may not within be entitled for a period up to three years thereafter, be eligible to within the discretion of and until notified by the Civil Service Commission, to take any Civil Service test or be eligible for appointment to any office or employment in the service of the City, ~~nor shall he during that time be entitled to take any Civil Service test.~~
