To establish guidelines for the leasing of City-owned real property. SAH DEGO, CALIFORNIA

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- 1. Catalog: A catalog of all real property owned in fee by the City will be maintained as an integral part of the Property Management Program listing size, location, zoning, development restrictions, and any other information pertinent to the status and use of each parcel.
- 2. Long-Term Leases: All leases in excess of two (2) years must be approved by resolution of the Council.
- 3. Short-Term Leases: The City Manager may execute leases of City-owned real property for terms of two (2) years or less. City Manager shall provide the Mayor and City Council with a quarterly report summarizing terms and conditions of new leases executed by the City Manager.
- 5. Standardized Lense Format: One standardized lease agreement form shall be reviewed and approved by Council for all flat-rate leases and another for all percentage-rate leases. Exceptions to this policy may be granted by resolution of Council upon the submission in writing of reasons deemed by Council to be good and sufficient.
- 6. Rates of Return: The City Council shall adopt by resolution capitalization rates of return for both short-term (2 years or less)

Revision to Council Policy 700-10, Exemption of certain Month-to Month Lental Agreements

It is requested that a Resolution be drafted for Council considerattion amending Council Policy 700-10 in the following manner:

Page 1, Paragraph 3. "Short Term Leases"

Add the following sentence at the end of the paragraph:

"Provided, however, that month-to-month rental agreements covering City-owned residential housing and Brown Field hirport Incubator Industries shall be exempted from provisions of Council Policy 700-10."

It is requested that an Ordinance be drafted for Council consideration amending Hamicipal Code Section 22.0901 "Leases of Real Property" by adding at the end of the paragraph the following:

"Rental agreements may be executed by the City Manager covering month-to-month tenant occupancy of City-owned residential housing or Brown Field Airport Incubator Industries and shall not be subject to the provisions of subparagraphs (a) through (d) of this section and occupancy of the facilities under such agreements may exceed two years."
