WHEREAS, the effect of being obsolete as to render property undesirable for further use may also encompass its being surplus to the needs of the City and hence obsolete to such needs, and therefore undesirable for retention; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that the City possesses as surplus to its needs 10,749, 1-15/16 inch diameter, silver, 200th Anniversary Medallions, and has notified the Purchasing Agent in writing to advertise said medallions for sale to the highest bidder to be smelted; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Purchasing Agent be and he is hereby authorized to advertise for sale 10,749, 1-15/16 inch diameter, silver, 200th Anniversary Medallions, said medallions being no longer utilized and having been determined to be obsolete to the needs of and undesirable for retention by The City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all expenses in connection with the above sale shall be deducted from the proceeds received from said sale.
