AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 33.0304 AND 33.0306, RELATING TO CITY LICENSE APPLICATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 3, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Sections 33.0304 and 33.0306, to read as follows:

SEC. 33.0304 ISSUANCE OR DENIAL OF LICENSE

Except as otherwise provided in this code, upon completion of the investigation, the Chief of Police or his designated representative shall issue the license, unless:

- (1) The applicant has knowingly made a false or misleading statement of a material fact or omission of a material fact in the application; or
- (2) The operation of the business as proposed, if permitted would not comply with all applicable building, fire, health and zoning laws; or
- (3) The applicant is under eighteen (18) years of age; or
- (4) The applicant has had a similar type of OCT 4 1978 license previously revoked for good cause within one (1) year immediately preceding the date of the filing of the

application, and can show no material changes in circumstances since such revocation; or

(5) The maintenance and operation of the business by the applicant will not comport with the peace, health, safety, convenience or general welfare of the public. This subsection shall not be applicable if the application is for a business involving free speech, free press or freedom of assembly.

SEC. 33.0306 TIME ALLOWED FOR INVESTIGATION

If the Chief of Police or other official, except the City Council, shall fail to act on any license application, and shall fail to notify the City Treasurer within thirty (30) days from the date of its delivery to him by the City Treasurer, said application shall be deemed to have been approved and the City Treasurer shall issue said license therefor, provided, however, that the Chief of Police or other official, upon written notification to the City Treasurer shall be allowed such additional time, not to exceed fourteen (14) days, as may reasonably be necessary to complete the investigation.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
