AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CON-
SENTING TO THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE
TIERRASANTA COMMUNITY ANTENNA TELEVISION
FRANCHISE GRANTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 10501 (N.S.).

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has by Ordinance No. 10501 (N.S.) granted the nonexclusive right, privilege and franchise to lay and use lines, wires, coaxial cable and appurtenances for transmitting, distributing and supplying radio and television antenna service along, across and upon the public streets, ways, alleys and places within the City of San Diego known as the Tierrasanta area to Tierrasanta Cable TV Association, predecessor in interest to Mission Cable TV, Inc., current holder of this franchise, as more particularly set forth in said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Cox Broadcasting Corporation is the majority stockholder of Cox Cable Communications, Inc., which is, in turn, sole owner of Mission Cable TV, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Cox Broadcasting Corporation proposes to transfer ownership of Mission Cable TV, Inc., through merger of Cox Cable Communications, Inc., into a newly formed, wholly owned subsidiary of Cox Broadcasting Corporation to be known as Cox Cable Communications, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Mission Cable TV, Inc., has by a letter dated April 22, 1977, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 760256, requested The City of San Diego to approve the aforementioned transfer of

ownership, as such approval might be deemed necessary in accordance with Section 8, paragraph (d) of Ordinance No. 10501 (N.S.); and

WHEREAS, the operation of the franchise held by Mission Cable, Inc., will not be affected thereby; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That The City of San Diego does by this ordinance consent to the transfer of ownership of Mission Cable TV, Inc., holder of the franchise granted by Ordinance No. 10501 (N.S.), from Cox Cable Communications, Inc., to a newly formed, wholly owned subsidiary of Cox Broadcasting Corporation.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


