AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VI, ARTICLE 2 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION-62.0108 RELATING TO FEE SCHEDULES FOR ENGINEERING PERMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter VI, Article 2 of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and it is hereby amended by amending Section 62.0108 to read as follows:

SEC. 62.0108 FEES UNDER THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE DETERMINED AND COLLECTED AS FOLLOWS:

- (a) A minimum fee of \$20 shall be collected on all permits issued.
- (b) A fee of ten percent of the bonded amount shall be collected on Encroachment permits and Public Improvement permits for which no plans are required. Where a drawing is required or the work proposed necessitates an investigation, an additional, nonrefundable fee of \$25 for checking or investigation shall be collected at the time the permit application is submitted. The remainder of fees will be collected at the time the permit is issued.
- Encroachment and Public Improvement permits requiring engineering plans, a deposit shall be paid to the City sufficient to cover the costs to the City of processing the permit application, such processing to include plan checks and field checks. If said deposit is insufficient to cover actual costs to City, such

additional deposits will be required as, in the opinion of the City Engineer, will be sufficient to cover such costs.

the actual costs of the City in processing a permit application will be refunded, but no funds will be released until all billings are in, and until final acceptance of the work by the City Engineer. In determining the actual costs incurred by the City in connection with the processing of final maps and improvement plans, the costs as recorded by the City Auditor and Comptroller shall be prima facia evidence of actual costs of services performed by the City. One half of the deposit shall be collected at the time of initial submission of the application to the City Engineer. The remaining one half of the deposit, adjusted to cover all estimated remaining costs, shall be paid in full at the time of permit issuance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
