AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1, DIVISION 4 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0423 RELATING TO THE CO ZONE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, Division 4 of the San Diego Municipal Code be, and it is hereby amended by amending Section 101.0423 to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0423 CO ZONE

(Commercial Office)

A. PURPOSE AND INTENT

The CO Zone is primarily intended to provide for business and professional offices and certain allied services normally associated with such offices. The CO Zone will normally be applied to encourage grouping of these office uses adjacent to such institutional facilities as hospitals, clinics and research complexes, or adjacent to major concentration of commercial activities.

Because of the specialized nature of the CO Zone, in terms of permitted commercial land usage, and because of its usual or frequent proximity to equal sensitive land uses, special sign regulations different from those contained in Division 11 of this Article are appropriate in the CO Zone. The regulations for on-premises signs located in the CO Zone are located in paragraph B.9. below. These regulations are intended to create a visual

atmosphere and environment conducive to the concentration of office-type commercial land use activities outside more intensive commercial districts and to maximize the compatibility of the CO Zone with other sensitive zones usually adjacent. The typical activity which seeks a CO Zone location does not require on-premises sign allowances as great as that required for the more intensively used commercial zones which depend heavily upon the attraction of consumers. The signage needs of the office activities desiring a CO Zone location are primarily related to identification purposes, and the sign allowances herein provide for this situation.

A. PURPOSE AND INTENT

The CO Zone is primarily intended to provide for business and professional offices and certain allied services normally associated with such offices. The CO Zone will normally be applied to encourage grouping of these office uses adjacent to such institutional facilities as hospitals, clinics and research complexes, or adjacent to major concentration of commercial activities.

Because of the specialized nature of the CO Zone, in terms of permitted commercial land usage, and because of its usual or frequent proximity to equally sensitive land uses, special sign 1.5 intended to requally sensitive land uses, special sign 1.5 intended to contained in Division 11 of this Article are as propriate in the CO Zone. The regulations for on-premises signs locater in the CO Zone are located in paragraph B.9. below.
