RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING AND DECLARING THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST, CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUIRE THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTE-NANCE OF A PUBLIC PARK AND INCIDENTS THERETO, WHICH WILL BE KNOWN AS ADOBE FALLS PARK, IN A PORTION OF LOT 67 OF RANCHO MISSION OF SAN DIEGO, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ACCORDING TO PARTITION MAP THEREOF IN THE ACTION ENTITLED "JUAN M. LUCO, ET AL., V. THE COMMERCIAL BANK OF SAN DIEGO, ET AL.," UNDER SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. 348 ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY CLERK OF SAID COUNTY; AND THAT THE PUBLIC INTEREST, CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY DEMAND THE ACQUISITION OF FEE TITLE AND EASEMENTS IN SAID PROPERTY FOR SAID PUBLIC PARK AND INCIDENTS THERETO: AND DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO ACQUIRE SAID PROPERTY AND EASEMENTS UNDER EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$61,500 FOR ACQUISITION AND CONDEMNATION COSTS; AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO COMMENCE AN ACTION IN THE SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDEMNING AND ACQUIRING SAID PROPERTY AND EASEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has provided notice to those persons designated in Section 1245.235, Code of Civil Procedure and also has provided all persons a reasonable opportunity to appear and be heard on the matters referred to in Section 1240.030, Code of Civil Procedure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the public interest, convenience and necessity of The City of San Diego, and the inhabitants thereof, require the construction, operation and maintenance of a public park and incidents thereto which will be known as ADOBE FALLS PARK in a portion of Lot 67 of Rancho Mission of San Diego, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California,

according to Partition Map thereof in the action entitled "Juan M. Luco, et al., v. the Commerical Bank of San Diego, et al.," under Superior Court Case No. 348 on file in the Office of the County Clerk of said County, as more particularly described hereinafter.

That the public interest, convenience and necessity of said City, and the inhabitants thereof, demand the acquisition and taking of fee title and easements in said property for the construction, operation and maintenance of said public park and incidents thereto, and the taking of the surplusage in fee simple, said real property lying within the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.

Section 3. That Section 220, the Charter of The City of San Diego; Sections 1240.010, 1240.110, 1240.120 and 1255.410, Code of Civil Procedure; Section 4090, Streets and Highways Code; Sections 6950 through 6954, 38002, 38010, 39732, 40401(b), 40404(b), and 51063, Government Code; Section 5301, Public Resources Code; and Section 61.0601.1, et seq., San Diego Municipal Code, permit the acquisition referenced herein.

That the parcel of real property and the interests sought to be condemned are described as follows:

That portion of Lot 67 of Ranch Mission of San Diego, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to Partition Map thereof made in the action entitled "Juan M. Luco, et al., v. the Commercial Bank of San Diego, et al.," under Superior Court Case No. 348 on file in the Office of the County Clerk of said County, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwesterly corner of Lot 899 of Del Cerro Unit No. 13, according to Map thereof No. 4572, filed in the Office of County Recorder of San Diego County on June 22, 1960; thence along the Southerly boundary of said Map 4572 as follows:

North 85°39'36" East, 766,92 feet; North 77°57'44" East, 913.73 feet; South 87°24'52" East, 307.45 feet; and South 73°01'16" East, 637.68 feet to the most Northerly corner of Lot 30 of College Canyon Park Unit No. 1, according to Map thereof No. 5232, filed in the Office of County Recorder of San Diego County; thence along the boundary of said Map 5232 as follows:

South 05°00'00" East, 269.50 feet to the certerline of Adobe Falls Road as shown on said Map and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing along said boundary South 05°00'00" East, 130.00 feet to an angle point South 88°43'21" East, 391.68 feet; South 81°50'52" East, 218.76 feet; South 45°43'13" East, 124.67 feet; and South 23°10'43" East, 215.76 feet to the Northerly line of land described in Parcel 2 in deed to the State of California, recorded November 25, 1941, in Book 1266, Page 475 of Official Records; thence along the Northerly line of said State of California land, North 77°50'16" West 1460.43 feet per Map No. 5232 Record North 77°48'30" West, 1468.06 feet to a concrete monument with City Engineer's Cap which marks an angle point therein; thence North 01°22'20" East along the prolongation of the Westerly line of the State of California property described in deed referred to above to an intersection with the Westerly prolongation of the centerline of Adobe Falls Road above described; thence along said prolongation North 85°16'08" East to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Section 5. That the taking and acquiring by said City of the now vacant and unoccupied real property and easements hereinabove described are deemed necessary for the construction, operation and maintenance of said public park and incidents thereto, by The City of San Diego and the inhabitants thereof, for municipal purposes; that such park and recreational uses are necessary for the community and are public uses authorized by law (Section 220, Charter of The City of San Diego; Sections 1240.010, 1240.110, 1240.120 and 1255.410, Code of Civil Procedure; Section 4090, Streets and Highways Code; Sections 6950 through 6954, 38002, 38010, 39732, 40401(b), 40404(b), and 51063, Government Code; Section 5301, Public Resources Code; and Section 61.0601.1, et seq.,

San Diego Municipal Code) that for such public uses it is necessary that The City of San Diego condemn and acquire said real property and easements; that said real property and easements are to be used for the construction, operation and maintenance of said public park and incidents thereto, which are planned and located in a manner most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.

Section 6. That for purposes of acquisitions and condemnation of said real property, the amount of \$61,500 is hereby allocated and authorized for expenditure for the above stated purposes. Said amount shall be composed of \$51,400 from Environmental Growth Fund No. 2505 and \$10,100 from Park Ordinance Fund No. 11381 as referenced in Auditors Certificate No. 8279.

Section 7. That the City Attorney of The City of San Diego, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to commence an action and seek an order of immediate possession of said real property in the Superior Court of the State of California, in and for the County of San Diego, in the name and on behalf of The City of San Diego, against all owners and claimants to any interests in the above-described real property, for the purpose of condemning and acquiring the fee interests and easements as above-described, for the use of said City.
