- 2. Woodson.
- 3. That the City Manager or his designated representative is hereby authorized to negotiate an offer to purchase to the State Public Works Board for the 396.6-acre Mt. Woodson site and to request the General Services Director and State Public Works Board to sell said property to The City of San Diego in accordance with applicable California Government Code provisions at the minimum cost consistent with that legislation.
- 4. That it is the intention of The City of San Diego to make communication sites available to the private sector, including but not limited to Palomar Communications Company, which are compatible with the present and future communications facilities at Mt. Woodson.
