RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the federal government has enacted legislation to impose mandatory unemployment insurance coverage upon public employees; and

WHEREAS, such federal intrusion upon local affairs places an unwarranted and undue fiscal burden upon local taxpayers and municipal governments; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that such invasion of state and local affairs be resisted on all fronts; and

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles has indicated it intends to challenge this federal legislation as unconstitutional and has requested other counties and cities assist wherever possible; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Attorney of San Diego be directed to join the County Counsel for the County of Los Angeles, to the extent available resources permit, in challenging the constitutionality of Public Law 94-566 that requires the California Legislature to enact the necessary legislation to provide mandatory unemployment insurance coverage for all public employees beginning January 1, 1978.
