WHEREAS, on February 7, 1977, the Rules Committee of the Council of The City of San Diego voted to initiate a "Business License Fee Study"; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of such study will be to review portions of the Municipal Code in order to determine the current rationale for levying the various business taxes; to make appropriate comparisons of business license tax rates and taxes paid by types of businesses in order to assess the equitability of each tax; and to recommend changes to the Code that would provide for a more consistent and equitable system for levying business taxes while maintaining the current level of revenues; and

WHEREAS, an estimated six months will be required to complete said comprehensive study of business license taxation; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that current personnel resources will be required as follows:

- a. Treasurer: Senior Typist (80 hours)
- b. Auditor: Principal Accountant (20 hours)
- c. Attorney: Deputy Attorney (80 hours)
- d. Police: Police Sergeant (80 hours)
- e. Financial Management:

Two CETA Administrative Analysts (6 months)
Clerical Assistance (120 hours)
