BACKGROUND

Amended Taxicab Policy

On December 16, 1976, the City Council amended Council Policy 500-2 "Taxicabs - Certificates of Convenience and Necessity." Briefly summarized, the amended policy establishes a two-year ceiling of 410 taxicab certificates, of which a minimum of 15 percent or 61 certificates are to be available to individual owner/operators. The amended policy also requires that individual owner/operators actually operate their taxicab at least one-third of the time, and further requires that within one year of the policy's adoption date, all certificate holders are to acquire radio dispatch-response capabilities.

Currently Authorized Certificates

Following the City Council's December 29th, 1976 authorization of the transfer of the 280 Yellow Cab certificates to Western States Transportation, Incorporated, a total of 339 taxicab certificates had been issued. The distribution of these certificates is shown in Table 1 below.

CERTIFICATES NOW AVAILABLE FOR ISSUANCE

Subtracting the 339 taxical certificates currently issued from the authorized ceiling of 410, leaves 71 outstanding taxical certificates available for issuance.

As noted earlier, a minimum of 61 of these outstanding 71 certificates are to be made available to individual owner/operator applicants. At the discretion of the Council, the ten remaining certificates may be issued to: a) existing taxicab firms requesting additional certificates; b) newly proposed taxicab firms or cooperatives; c) additional individual owner/operator applicants; or d) any combination thereof.

Certificate Requests: Existing Operators

There are presently six applications from existing taxicab firms for 24 additional certificates of public convenience and necessity. These requests are shown in Table 2 below.

Additionally, 123 requests for 512 certificates have been received, to date, from prospective (new) taxicab operators, including 108 individual owner/ operator applications. These applications are summarized in Table 3 on page 3.

Therefore, by adding the data presented in Tables 2 and 3, the combined current demand from both existing and prospective operators for additional taxicab certificates totals 129 separate requests for 536 additional certificates. These applicants are serially listed by the date their application was filed with the City Clerk. (See Appendix I attached to this report.)

CITY MANAGER'S FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Section 72.0101, paragraph (d) of the Municipal Code requires that "Before any application is acted upon the City Manager shall cause an investigation to be made and shall report his findings, in writing, to the Council on the following:

- (1) The demand of the public for additional taxicab service;
- (2) The adequacy of existing mass transportation and taxicab service;
- (3) The financial responsibility and experience of the applicant;
- (4) The number, kind, and type of equipment and color scheme to be used;
- (5) The effect which such additional taxicab service may have upon traffic congestion and parking;
- (6) Whether the additional taxicab service will result in a greater hazard to the public;
- (7) Such other relevant facts as the Council may deem advisable or necessary."

Because item 4 above is necessarily related to each specific application, information concerning the number and type of vehicles is on file with the Department of Transportation, while data regarding proposed vehicle color schemes is on file with the San Diego Police Department.

MICROFILMED 21'7931 JUN 1 1978 Findings relative to the other items, however, can be discussed collectively.

- (1) Public demand for additional taxicab service: Presently, the apparent declining trend in total paid taxicab trips does not seem to substantiate the need for additional taxicab service in the City. However, it should be noted that individual owner/operators who provide a high level of professional service may be able to generate additional public demand for taxicab service.
- (2) Adequacy of existing mass transportation and taxicab service: Existing mass public transportation does not appear to adequately meet the total transportation needs of the community. It must be stressed that local transportation needs are extremely varied, and require a multi-modal approach, including fixed bus routes, dial-a-ride service, and automobiles-for-hire, as well as taxicab service.
- (3) Applicants' financial responsibility and experience: The applicants' financial responsibility and experience have been checked satisfactorily. Information regarding the financial responsibility and experience of specific applicants is on file with the Department of Transportation.
- (5) Impact of additional taxicab service upon traffic congestion and parking: It is not felt that the issuance of up to an additional 71 taxicab certificates, as allowed under the amended policy, will worsen, in any measurable way, local traffic congestion and parking problems.
- (6) Additional taxicab service generating a greater hazard to the public: If the provisions of the Municipal Code regarding the operation of taxicabs are faithfully adhered to by all certificate holders, and if the present level of enforcement is maintained, no greater hazard to the public is anticipated.

In accordance with the provision of Council Policy 500-2 (Taxicabs - Certificates of Convenience and Necessity) that at least 15 percent of the authorized certificates shall be held by individual owner/operators, it is recommended that 61 of the 71 outstanding taxicab certificates be issued to individual owner/operator applicants on the basis of the date their application was filed with the City Clerk.

In order to increase the level of parity among existing taxicab operators, it is recommended that the ten remaining certificates be issued in sets of two each, to the five smallest taxicab operators requesting additional taxicab certificates. Approval of this recommendation would result in the issuance of two additional taxicab certificates to each of the following operators: Brown & White Cab Co., City Cab Co., Martin Cab Co., Radio Cab Co., and Red Cab of San Diego.

It is recommended that all pending and future applications for taxicab certificates be held until such certificates become available for issuance.

At the conclusion of the hearing, the City Council shall determine: a) whether the public convenience and necessity require the issuance of these certificates and, b) the basis for distribution of any issued certificates to the various applicants.
