BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the following findings are made in respect to the significant environmental impacts identified in Environmental Impact Report No. 76-04-32P.

- 1. No mitigation of the cumulative effects of traffic has been identified. The effect of the proposed project is not, in itself, significant.
- 2. The proposed landscaping plan will improve the visual quality of the site which has been graded in the past. It is economically infeasible to landscape the existing cut banks. Additional landscaping in conjunction with future development of the balance of the pad area will lessen the visual impact of the cut bank.
