WHEREAS, the Nejedly-Hart State, Urban and Coastal Park

Bond Act of 1976 (Proposition 2) was adopted, and approximately

\$6.3 million has been designated to San Diego County under

Section 5096.124(a) "grants to counties, cities, and districts";

and

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego is required to develop and submit to the State a priority plan for expenditure of these funds after consultation with local cities and districts and indication of approval therefrom; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that approval is granted to a priority plan developed by the County of San Diego which meets the following criteria:

- That the primary emphasis be upon acquisition and/or development of those major regional projects listed on Exhibit A, attached and made a part hereof, and that allocations be substantially in the proportions shown thereon.
- 2. That \$50,000 each be allocated to those eligible districts not directly benefited by projects listed on Exhibit A.
- 3. That cities not directly benefited by projects listed on Exhibit A, notably those in the northern section of the County, be allocated sums which are substantially in proportion to the total County allocation (minus that allocated to the districts) as their populations are in proportion to the total County population.

4. That the remaining funds after subtracting the allocations in 2 and 3 above be allocated to the acquisition and/or developments in connection with the projects listed on Exhibit A; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the Council's intention that funds currently scheduled for expenditure in The City of San Diego's Capital Improvement Program for acquisitions and/or improvements, which can be directly identified as part of projects listed on Exhibit A, shall be reallocated for other City park and recreation projects as the Nejedly-Hart funds become allocated.
