WHEREAS, some anticipated benefits from this program are reduced staff requirements, better service to departments, improved public relations, and immediate and effective responses to State and Federal compliance agencies; and

WHEREAS, this project will be in two phases, the first of which is to conduct a study to determine the cost of such program and a system of implementation; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this study, Council will be further advised of the cost of fully implementing the program of automating the City's personnel system; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer within the General Fund 100 the sum of

\$21,500 from the Unallocated Reserve (53.31) to Data Processing Department (14.20), Object Account 1151, to be used solely and exclusively for defraying personal expenses of two 0.5 year positions to be used in a cost effectiveness study of automating the applicant flow and testing portions of the Personnel Department's examining and selection procedures.
