That the bids of (1) MASTER TRUCK, a division of Hallamore, Inc., and (2) ABLE BODY CO., INC. are hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contracts for the purchase of 21 side-loading refuse trucks as follows:

- Master Truck, a division of Hallamore, Inc., for Alternate A, Item No. 3, for ten each 50,000 GVW cab and chassis for a cost of \$41,072 each with option for extra suspension of \$108 per truck, an option for neutral interlock of \$360 per truck, and a delivery charge of 35¢/mile for 380 miles for a cost of \$41,673 per truck, terms net 30 days plus sales tax less trade-in allowance of \$800 each for ten used refuse trucks; Alternate B, Item 4, for 11 each 37,000 GVW cab and chassis for a cost of \$37,280 each plus a neutral interlock option for \$360 per truck and delivery charge of 35¢/mile for 380 miles for cost of \$37,773 per truck less trade-in allowance of \$9,600 total for 11 used refuse trucks; with option to purchase six additional cab and chassis at the same price and terms less trade-in allowance of \$1,000 each for six used refuse trucks, option to be exercised by September 1, 1977.

Alternate C, Item 6 for 11 each 29 cubic yard side-loading refuse bodies for a cost of \$11,465 each less credit for pump of \$90 per body and less credit for floor of \$65 per body for a cost of \$11,310 per body; terms net 30 days plus sales tax, with an option to purchase six additional refuse bodies at the same price, terms and conditions by September 1, 1977.
- That the acceptance of the above referenced bid of Able Body Co., Inc. is specifically conditioned upon the oral and written agreement by Able Body, Co., Inc. to indemnify and save The City of San Diego harmless, including all expense of investigation and defense should a suit for patent infringement be brought against the City as a consequence of the award of said contract.
- That the acceptance of the above referenced bid by Able Body Co., Inc. is also specifically conditioned on the agreement of Able Body Co., Inc. to provide to City a certificate of deposit or indemnity bond in the amount of \$50,000 in the event the City should be named by Maxon Industries, Inc. in a patent infringement suit; the principal amount of any certificate to be held by City and for the payment of damages incurred by City as a result of such patent infringement suit.
