WHEREAS, rescheduling of the above projects to Fiscal Year 1978 is provided for in the proposed Fiscal Year 1978 budget, or will be proposed incident to Council budget reviews; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of \$11,293,000 in capital improvement funds allocated to projects in the Fiscal Year 1977 CIP budget into CIP reserves, as more fully set forth in the Table of Proposed Fund Transfers attached hereto as Attachment A.
