BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the Department of Legislative Representation is hereby directed to take all necessary action, for and on behalf of The City of San Diego, to declare the City's opposition to Senate Bill 650 relating to the establishment of a statewide litter control, recycling and resource recovery program unless the measure is amended to: (1) delete the one dollar (\$1.00) per ton surcharge on solid waste disposal or exempt public agencies from such surcharge; (2) exempt "group 3" wastes from the surcharge; (3) delete the percentage distribution of litter control funds; and (4) distribute the funds to local governments according to population and allow local governments to determine priorities and uses for litter control funds.
