DRAFT POLICY

CITY PARTICIPATION IN SCHOOL TURFED AREAS

BACKGROUND

During the past two years the City of San Diego has worked cooperatively with the San Diego Unified School District in the turfing of school sites. This work was accomplished without formal policy guidelines and without consideration for total City-wide needs.

PURPOSE

To establish guidelines for future development of turfing of school sites.

POLICY

- 1. City will work cooperatively with school districts in the development of turfed athletic areas where deficiencies exist, and where adequate playground acreage is available to accommodate such turfed areas.
- 2. City participation in the joint development of turfed fields will be according to the following criteria:
 - a. The City will notify the school district of park deficiencies and the City's priorities for turfing fields.
 - b. When school district(s) have funding available, the cost of development shall be assumed by the participating school district(s).
 - c. The size and design of the area must accommodate a variety of activities, e.g., youth baseball, soccer, football.
 - d. Plans and specifications for the area to be developed by the school district(s) must be approved by City prior to the beginning of construction.
 - e. Turfed areas shall be constructed for school/community use and not specifically for any group or organization.
 - f. A written agreement between the City and district(s) will guarantee community use during non-school hours.
 - g. The City has adequate funds available for maintenance of said areas, including utilities.
- 3. When criteria in numbers 1 and 2 above *** been met, the district(s) shall lease said turfed areas to City.
