WHEREAS, The City of San Diego executed a Voluntary Compliance Agreement with the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA) pursuant to City Council Resolution No. 215965 dated May 12, 1976, and on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 755482; and

WHEREAS, it was agreed therein that the City would conduct an overall review of all minority and female probationary police officers who had been terminated or who resigned since January 1, 1974, to that date; and

WHEREAS, it was further agreed that in conjunction with said review, where warranted, a recommendation of reinstatement with back pay, with appropriate offsets, would be made to the Civil Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined and so recommended to the Civil Service Commission that eleven (11) individuals be so reinstated; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to process said back payments pursuant to prior Council authorization and the Voluntary Compliance Agreement cited hereinabove; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That pursuant to that certain agreement between LEAA and The City of San Diego entitled, "Voluntary Compliance Agreement," on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 755482, and prior Council authorization, the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to issue warrants in the following amounts, less all appropriate deductions as required by federal and state law, to the following named individuals:
