

SUBJECT: Agreement with the National League

REFERENCE: Item 208, Docket of May 11, 1977

This item was continued for two weeks during which time the City Manager was to: (1) Negotiate all demands discussed thus far with the Padres; and (2) determine the total cost to provide the Padres with Police traffic control for the period 1969 through 1976.

(1) PADRE DEMANDS/SETTLEMENT

Curtis Fitzpatrick, Senior Chief Deputy City Attorney and William MacFarlane, Property Director, met with E. J. Bavasi, President, San Diego Padres, on May 18, 1977 in an effort to determine Padre demands and negotiate a settlement. Mr. Bavasi identified the following Padre demands:

- DEMAND 1 Payment of Rental for the Directors' Area (Baseball Box) in the amount of \$134,803.
- SETTLEMENT: Withdrawal of demand providing the City assures the Padres that it will control the indiscriminate use of the tickets.
- DEMAND 2 Claim for reimbursement of free admissions during the period 1969 through 1973 in the approximate amount of \$660,991.50. SETTLEMENT: Claim withdrawn.
- DEMAND 3 Disputed Promotional Fee in the amount of \$39,927.
- SETTLEMENT: The amendment to the Promotion Agreement has been signed by Ray Kroc and E. J. Bavasi and if approved by the City Council would eliminate the disputed payment.
- DEMAND 4 Reimbursement for expenses in the amount of \$11,372.49 relating to the San Diego Stadium Management Company operations from 1969 through 1973 which were paid by the Padre organization. Mr. Bavasi claims that additional security services were required for the use and control of the Directors' Area (Baseball Box).
- SETTLEMENT: Mr. Bavasi is of the opinion that the Padres should receive credit in the amount of the claim (\$11,372.49) against the Promotion Payback fee.

(2) POLICE TRAFFIC CONTROL COSTS IN SUPPORT OF PADRE EVENTS

The Police Department, during the years 1969 through 1976, charged the time spent in traffic control at San Diego Stadium to its "Special Events" account. This account covers all charges connected with Rock Concerts, Parades, Athletic Events, etc. In the course of special studies conducted in 1973 and 1976, charges directly related to Padre games were isolated. Therefore, utilizing these actual figures as a base, the costs attributable to the Padres for the eight seasons (1969-1976) have been estimated to be \$257,469. The criteria for Police Department traffic control staffing for events at San Diego Stadium is as follows:

Anticipated attendance per game - 20,000 or less - 2 Officers
20,000 - 35,000 - 5 Officers, 1 Supervisor
Over 35,000 - 10 Officers, 2 Supervisors

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the settlement terms; approve the amended Promotion Agreement and authorize the City Auditor to issue a warrant in the amount of \$106,586.99 payable to the San Diego Padres Baseball Club.
