

DECORATION OF PUBLIC STRUCTURES
BY PRIVATE CITIZENS

(Version Approved by PFR on 3-28-77)

BACKGROUND

Requests by various groups and individuals for permission to decorate City-owned buildings with murals have increased with the corresponding increase in popularity of this art form.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish procedures for application and review of future requests to decorate City-owned facilities.

POLICY

It is the policy of the City Council that all requests to decorate City-owned facilities shall be reviewed in the manner outlined below prior to action of the City Council.

PROCEDURE

- I. Written requests shall be submitted to the City Manager. Requests must include detailed graphics of the design; material and workmanship specifications, color palette; proposed implementation procedures and time frames; and evidence of sufficient financing to complete the work, including a statement that requestor will provide all labor, material and equipment and will maintain the decoration for a minimum of seven years.

- II. The City Manager will forward requests to the cognizant City department for review and comment. In the case of Library and Park and Recreation facilities, their respective citizen advisory groups shall review the requests, and their recommendations will be included, in a Report to Council.
 - a. Park and Recreation Facilities - To ensure that proposals for decorations on park facilities are consistent with the desires of the community, an affirmative recommendation shall be sought from the following advisory groups as applicable.
 1. Area Committee of the Park and Recreation Board
 2. Facilities Committee of the Park and Recreation Board
 3. Park and Recreation Board
 - b. Library Facilities - An affirmative recommendation shall be sought from the Board of Library Commissioners.
- III. In addition to the recommendations of the involved departments and advisory boards as applicable, all graphics and specifications shall be reviewed by the Public Service Projects Review Committee.
- IV. Final approval of the City Council is conditioned upon adherence to the proposed design. Variations from the proposed design detail in the "as built" project will be reported to the City Council with a recommendation from the City Manager and advisory boards as appropriate. Removal and/or modification of the projects found to vary from the proposal shall be accomplished by the requestor. Approval by Council does not imply or provide for City maintenance or touch-up to repair vandalism damage or structural or building repair work.
- V. All applications shall acknowledge the right of the City to remove or paint over the decorations and release the City from any liability for claims resulting from such action.
Removal or repainting shall only be undertaken with authorization of the City Council.
