WHEREAS, the Public Works Employment Act of 1976, Title II, as amended by the Intergovernmental Anti-Recession Assistance Act of 1977, provides for federal financial assistance for the maintenance of basic public services during periods of high unemployment and recession; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is an eligible recipient of such financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, the federal government requires that the funds allocated to The City of San Diego be expended, appropriated or obligated by October 11, 1977; and

WHEREAS, present practice for the advertising of bids for repair and maintenance projects requires Council action for a resolution authorizing advertising for bids whenever a project is undertaken; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence to initiate these repair and maintenance projects in order to meet the intent of the legislation as an anti-recession measure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego; as follows:

1. That the Purchasing Agent of The City of San Diego
be and he is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to publish
in accordance with law, notice to contractors calling for bids
for approximately 100 maintenance and repair projects totalling
an amount not to exceed \$440,000 to be funded by funds made
available by the Office of Revenue Sharing pursuant to the Public CU554

Works Employment Act of 1976, Title II, as amended, provided that plans and specifications for the furnishing of all labor, material, tools, transportation and other expense necessary or incidental for said approved repair and maintenance projects shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, California, prior to any publishing being made hereunder.

- 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to appropriate and encumber \$440,000 from Title II Trust Fund 2681 for the purpose of building repair and maintenance and related pathway and parking surface repair and for related expenditures including the acquisition of services, materials and supplies.
- 3. That by Resolution No. 218685, adopted June 22, 1977, this Council ascertained the current or prevailing rate of per diem wages paid by private employers in the City for each craft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the contract, and this Council does hereby declare that the wage scale included in said resolution is the said current or prevailing rate for the various crafts that will be applicable to projects approved and accomplished pursuant to the Public Works Employment Act of 1976, Title II, as amended.
