

RESOLUTION NO. 219000

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council, by resolution dated August 2, 1977, did authorize the City Manager to negotiate a contract without advertising or calling for bids pursuant to the emergency provisions of City Charter Section 94 to repair the PACIFIC HIGHWAY SEWER between Sassafras Street and Laurel Street; and

WHEREAS, negotiations with general contractors qualified to perform this type of work have resulted in M. ARRIETA & SON INC., a corporation, offering to perform the needed work at a low offer of \$524,015; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the bid of \$524,015 by M. ARRIETA & SON INC., a corporation, for renovation and construction of the PACIFIC HIGHWAY SEWER of approximately 2,685 feet of trunk sewer line between Laurel Street and Sassafras Street, in the City of San Diego, California, is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract therefor in accordance with the form on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 760527.

2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$672,000 within Sewer Revenue Fund 506 from Unallocated Reserve 69.97 to CIP 43-028, and that expenditure of said funds is hereby authorized, solely and exclusively for the

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
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purpose of providing funds for this purpose and related costs.

3. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to do by City Forces all necessary work in connection with bypass pumping of sewage and operational checks for the above-referenced project pursuant to the recommendation of the City Manager and the submission of his estimates indicating said work can be done more economically by City Forces than if let by contract, at a cost not to exceed \$50,000.
