BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that pursuant to California Public Resources Code, Section 21081, the following findings are made with respect to the environmental impacts identified in ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT NO. 76-01-06P:

- 1. The "no project" alternative is economically infeasible to the owner in that she will have to continue to pay taxes on land which is allowed no reasonable, permissible, private use.
- 2. The "alternative open space project" is economically and socially infeasible because:
  - A. City funds are not currently available for immediate acquisition;
  - B. A park assessment district or a purchase by adjacent owners would likely fail in view of unsuccessful efforts by the owner to sell the property in the past; and
  - C. In all events, the public acquisition of the land in question would reduce the tax base and require an expenditure of public monies with no commensurate benefit in that the final E.I.R. discloses that the canyon's environmental value is not in human use.
