WHEREAS, the Joint City-County Task Force on redlining has prepared a report on home lending patterns in San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego has agreed to continue the study of lending patterns to obtain further information: and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego has also approved the formation of a Joint City-County Reinvestment Task Force to explore methods of cooperative reinvestment with lending institutions in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to continue its support of and cooperation in these laudable efforts; NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of The City of San Diego hereby expresses its intention to participate in the Reinvestment Task Force and hereby informs the Board of Supervisors of the County of that intent.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Councilman Jess Haro is hereby designated as the City Council's participating member.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Greater Golden Hills Planning Association and Southeast San Diego Development Committee are hereby designated as organizations which will participate in this Task Force.
