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A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 215000 ADOPTED DECEMBER 31, 1975; DESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF THE IMPERIAL AVENUE (ESCUELA STREET TO 61ST STREET) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT, LYING WEST OF THE EASTERLY LINE OF ALLEY, BLOCK 16, LAS ALTURAS NO. 4, AND SHOWN ON CITY CLERK'S DOCUMENT NO. 750479, AS THE PHASE I SECTION, AND THAT PORTION OF SAID DISTRICT LYING EAST OF SAID EASTERLY ALLEY LINE AND SHOWN ON SHEET 2 OF CITY CLERK'S DOCUMENT NO. 750479, AS THE PHASE II SECTION; AND DESIGNATING OCTOBER 21, 1977 AS THE DATE UPON WHICH ALL PROPERTY IN THE PHASE II SECTION MUST BE READY TO RECEIVE UNDERGROUND SERVICE AND DECEMBER 1, 1977 AS THE DATE FOR THE REMOVAL OF ALL OVERHEAD UTILITY FACILITIES FROM THE PHASE II SECTION.

WHEREAS, this Council did on April 24, 1975 by Resolution No. 213094 establish the IMPERIAL AVENUE (Escuela Street to 61st Street) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT which required the conversion of certain overhead electric, communication and community antenna television facilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Resolution No. 213094 the date upon which property in the district had to be ready to receive underground service and the date upon which the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures had to be effected was to be subsequently designated by resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That Resolution No. 215000 adopted by the City Council on December 31, 1975 be and it is hereby rescinded.

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- 2. That portion of the IMPERIAL AVENUE (Escuela Street to 61st Street) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT lying west of the easterly line of Alley, Block 16, Alturas No. 4, and shown on sheet 1 of City Clerk's Document No. 750479, is designated as the PHASE I SECTION, and that portion of said district lying east of said easterly alley line and shown on sheet 2 of City Clerk's Document No. 750479 is designated as the PHASE II SECTION.
- 3. That October 21, 1977 be and the same is hereby established and designated as the date upon which all property in the PHASE II SECTION within the IMPERIAL AVENUE (Escuela Street to 61st Street) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT must be ready to receive underground utility service and that December 1, 1977 be and the same is hereby designated as the date upon which all overhead utility facilities must be removed from the PHASE II SECTION.
- 4. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice to all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this Resolution No. 219417 within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall specifically notify the affected persons that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service, they shall provide, at their own expense, all necessary facility changes on their premise so as to receive underground service



from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

5. The City Manager is hereby directed to notice such affected persons and affected utilities in accordance with Section 61.0511(b) of the San Diego Municipal Code.
