WHEREAS, the seasonally adjusted rate of unemployment for the San Diego area is substantially above the national average at 9.6 percent; and

WHEREAS, it would be desirable for businesses and industry to look to and direct their recruiting efforts at local citizenry when recruiting for employees; and

WHEREAS, unemployment excesses as exist in San Diego can be resolved only by such conscientious efforts on the part of the united community of employers; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of all the people of this city, urge and encourage all employers, business and industry, when hiring new employees, to direct their employment efforts at and give favorable consideration to their fellow San Diegans in the local labor force.
