WHEREAS, the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning may consent to review for possible funding the project submitted by The City of San Diego referred to as "ARJIS-City of San Diego, 3rd Year," on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 761847; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit to and to execute with the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning on behalf of said City, the application for grant for law enforcement purposes.
2. That in the event the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning consents to fund the above project from funds made available through the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act, The City of San Diego agrees to accept the grant and designates the City Manager to execute, for and on behalf of said City, the contract for the grant for law enforcement purposes, including any extensions or amendments thereof which do not require an additional expenditure of City funds.
3. That The City of San Diego hereby allocates the required \$24,200 cash match in Fiscal Year 1978 from the Police Department budget to said project under the Safe Streets Act and the rules and regulations of the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning and the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration.

5. That the City Manager is hereby authorized, according to all legal requirements, to negotiate and execute agreements for contractual services that are within the scope of the grant contract on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 761847 and the City Manager shall periodically report to Council on the progress of the grant project.
