WHEREAS, San Diego currently benefits from a full service

HUD insuring office, but reorganization plans call for moving the

multi-family mortgaging and management responsibilities, and the

Equal Opportunity responsibilities to a Los Angeles area office; and

WHEREAS, many activities currently performed by the San Diego office require timely on-site project management and the transfer would impede performance of these operations; and

WHEREAS, the local Equal Opportunity staff and several community organizations have worked closely to help eliminate discriminatory practices and a move could have a very negative effect on this relationship; and

WHEREAS, San Diego is a rapidly growing community which has worked diligently towards developing a growth management strategy, redeveloping the downtown area and improving its transportation systems, all of which necessitate the physical proximity of HUD services for future development; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of The City of San Diego does hereby request reconsideration of the decision to transfer the Multi-family Housing and Equal Opportunity Sections of the San Diego HUD office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego supports the retention of a HUD service office with Multi-family Housing and Equal Opportunity units.
