UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT.

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AND DENOMINATED AS THE BEYER BOULEVARD (1-805 TO ROUTE 75)

whereas, by Resolution No. 219474 , a public hearing was called for on NOV 16 1977 at the hour of 2:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within that certain area of the City of San Diego more particularly described as follows:

The northerly 50 feet of Lots 1 and 2 in SAN YSIDRO RESUBDIVISION NO. 1 of LOT A-6, MAP NO. 4560; that portion of Lots A-79 through A-84, SAN YSIDRO ADDITION, MAP NO. 1174, north of the SAN DIEGO AND ARIZONA EASTERN RAILWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY in SAN YSIDRO; the southerly 100 feet of SAN DIEGO COUNTY ASSESSOR'S PARCEL NO. 638-060-09, a part of SECTION 35, T18S-R2W, R.O.S. 7053; the southerly 25 feet of Lots A-216 and A-217 and the southerly 100 feet of Lots A-218 through A-221 of SAN YSIDRO ADDITION 4, MAP 1324; the southerly 150 feet of Lots A-178 through A-183 and the southerly 25 feet of Lot A-186, SAN YSIDRO ADDITION 2, MAP 1246; Lot A-177, excluding the area between the northerly lot line and a line parallel to and 10 feet south of said northerly line, SAN YSIDRO ADDITION 2, MAP 1246; Lot A-222, excluding the area between the northerly lot line and a line parallel to and 10 feet south of said northerly line, SAN YSIDRO ADDITION 5, MAP 1405; SAN DIEGO COUNTY ASSESSOR'S PARCEL NOS. 637-020-09, 10 and 54, a part of Section 35, T18S-R2W, R.O.S. 8025.

Said district shall also include the following described public rights-of-way:

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BEYER BOULEVARD, bounded on the northwest by Highway 75 and the east by Interstate 805; OTAY MESA ROAD, between the northerly line of Beyer Boulevard and a line parallel to and 300 feet north of said northerly line; NORTH LANE, between the northerly line of Beyer Boulevard and a line parallel to and 100 feet north of said northerly line.

and all as more particularly shown on Drawing Nos. 17441-1D and 2D entitled "BEYER BOULEVARD (I-805 to Route 75) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT," copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 761531 and attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing has been given by the City

Clerk to all affected property owners as defined in Chapter VI,

Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and the

utilities concerned in the manner and for the time required by

law; and

WHEREAS, such hearing has been duly and regularly held and all persons interested have been given an opportunity to be heard; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Council does hereby find and determine that the public health, safety and general welfare require the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service within the area set forth above and that pursuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the above-described area is hereby declared to be

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an underground utility district in the City of San Diego, and the maps and document referred to above are hereby incorporated as a part of this resolution.

2. That pussuant to Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code the following exception shall be allowed in said underground utility district:

Two utility poles, one on each side of Beyer Boulevard at the crosswalk approximately 150 feet northerly of the Smythe Avenue intersection, are to remain now and be removed later with the Smythe Avenue district.

- 3. The City Council shall by subsequent resolution fix the date upon which the property in the district must be ready to receive underground service, and shall by subsequent resolution order the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service.
- 4. The City Clerk be and he is hereby instructed to notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code, and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this resolution within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall further notify said affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code of the necessity that if they desire to continue to receive electric communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service, they shall provide at their own expense all necessary

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facility changes on their premises so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California (as of the date of adoption of this resolution) and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.
