WHEREAS, the California State Legislature reported this year that there are thousands of women in this State who are regularly beaten, tortured and even killed by spouses or persons with whom they are living and that those women have no immediate access to private counseling and shelter for themselves and their children; and

WHEREAS, hundreds of battered women have contacted social service and mental health agencies for assistance in recent months in San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Mayor and City Council support the November 30, 1977, rally sponsored by the Battered Women's Coalition and furthermore support the communitywide efforts presently taking place to expose the extent of the problem of battered women, to educate the public as to the nature and severity of the crime of domestic violence, to assist battered women in attaining a life free from physical abuse and to advocate legislative and public policy changes which favor battered women.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council support the concept of establishing emergency shelters in
