A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF THE PALM AVENUE (1-5) TO HAWAII AVENUE) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT LYING WEST OF THE EASTERLY LINE OF BEYER BOULEVARD AS THE WESTERLY SECTION, AND THAT PORTION OF SAID DISTRICT LYING EAST OF SAID EASTERLY LINE OF BEYER BOULEVARD AS THE EASTERLY SECTION; DESIGNATING FEBRUARY 6, 1978 AS THE DATE UPON WHICH ALL PROPERTY IN THE WESTERLY SECTION MUST BE READY TO RECEIVE UNDERGROUND SERVICE AND MAY 1, 1978 AS THE DATE FOR THE REMOVAL OF ALL OVERHEAD UTILITY FACILITIES FROM SAID WESTERLY SECTION.


WHEREAS, this Council did on October 30, 1975 by Resolution No. 214569 establish the PALM AVENUE (I-5 to Hawaii Avenue)

UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT which required the conversion of certain overhead electric, communication and community antenna television facilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Resolution No. 214569, the date upon which property in the district had to be ready to receive underground service and the date upon which the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures had to be effected was to be subsequently designated by resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That portion of the PALM AVENUE (I-5 to Hawaii Avenue)
UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT lying west of the easterly line
of Beyer Boulevard is designated as the WESTERLY SECTION, and
that portion of said district lying east of said easterly line
of Beyer Boulevard is designated as the EASTERLY SECTION.



- 2. That February 6, 1978 be and the same is hereby established and designated as the date upon which all property in the westerly section within the PALM AVENUE (I-5 to Hawaii Avenue) UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT must be ready to receive underground utility service and that May 1, 1978 be and the same is hereby designated as the date upon which all overhead utility facilities in said westerly section must be removed.
- That the City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice to all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code and all affected utility companies of the adoption of this Resolution No. 219868 within fifteen (15) days after the date of such adoption. The City Clerk shall specifically notify the affected persons that if they desire to continue to receive electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service, they shall provide, at their own expense, all necessary facility changes on their premise so as to receive underground service from the lines relocated underground of the supplying utility company subject to applicable rules, regulations and tariffs of the respective utility company on file with the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California and subject to all other applicable requirements of State law and City ordinances. The Clerk's notification shall be made in the manner provided in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

4. The City Manager is hereby directed to give notice to such affected persons and affected utilities in accordance with Section 61.0511(b) of the San Diego Municipal Code.
