WHEREAS, George Coleman Conrad has been a principal part of San Diego City Council operations for the better part of a decade; and

WHEREAS, Coleman Conrad has, since joining City public service in 1968, consistently provided first-rate fiscal and administrative analyses to enable San Diego's City legislators to make better decisions for the people; and

WHEREAS, in 1972 he earned the gratitude of the San Diego City Council by ably helping to reorganize legislative services into departments in order to provide the taxpayers with greater legislative responsibility and accountability; and

WHEREAS, he served a progression of deputy mayors as an invaluable assistant, handling literally thousands of constituent complaints, inquiries and suggestions; and

WHEREAS, in 1974 Coleman Conrad helped create the City Council Committee System for San Diego and, as such, became the senior consultant to the Council's key Committee on Rules and Legislation which not only charged him with the evaluation of important City programs and budgets but with the responsibility of preparing City Council agendas--insuring the smooth operation of City legislative business; and

WHEREAS, Coleman Conrad achieved a major personal goal by passing the California Bar three years ago, entitling him to practice law; and
