BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San . Diego, that pursuant to California Public Resources Code,
Section 21081, the following findings are made with respect to the environmental impacts identified in the First Amendment to Environmental Impact Report No. 75-01-18:

Off-site conditions remain generally similar to those originally assessed, and the environmental resources identified in the previous report. Though the new proposal represents twice as much biotic destruction, the relative value of remaining natural land along eastern Miramar Road is moderately low due to the previous proliferation of industrial developments in the area.
