AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RULES 1 AND 3 OF SECTION 22.0101 OF CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF COUNCIL AND COUNCIL COMMITTEE MEETINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Rule 1 of Section 22.0101 of Chapter II,
Article 2, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be
amended to read as follows:

## Rule 1. Hours of Meetings

(a) The regular weekly meetings of the City Council shall be scheduled as follows:

Monday

2:00 p.m. - 5:30 p.m.

Tuesday

8:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m.

- (b) A single docket covering the regular Council meetings each week shall be published.
- (c) The time of a meeting may be extended beyond the time specified above by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members of the Council.
- (d) Regular Council meetings shall be held in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, Community Concourse, in the City of San Diego, California. In the event a regular meeting shall fall on a legal holiday, the meeting may be held on the next business day.

- (e) The Council may by resolution, when necessary, change the time and place of the regular meeting. The resolution shall set forth the circumstances necessitating such change. Such resolution shall be published once in the City official newspaper at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the meeting to be held pursuant to such change. Twenty-four hours prior to the meeting to be held pursuant to such change, the City Clerk shall give each Councilman written notice, personally or by registered mail, of any change from the regular meeting days established by this section.
- (f) A special meeting may be called at any time by the Mayor or by a majority of the members of the Council by delivering personally or by mail written notice to each member of the Council and to each local newspaper of general circulation, radio or television station requesting notice in writing. Such notice must be delivered personally or by mail at least twenty-four (24) hours before the time of such meeting as specified in the notice. The call and notice shall specify the time and place of the special meeting and the businessto be transacted. No other business shall be considered at such meetings by the Council. Such written notice may be dispensed with as to any member who at or prior to the time the meeting convenes files with the City Clerk a written waiver of notice. Such waiver may be given by telegram. Such written notice may also be

dispensed with as to any member who is actually present at the meeting at the time it convenes.

Section 2. That Rule 3 of Section 22.0101 of Chapter II,
Article 2, Division 1, of the San Diego Municipal Code be
amended to read as follows:

## Rule 3. Procedure for Council Meetings

The order of business for Council meetings shall be as follows:




