AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3,
DIVISION 35, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 33.3510, RELATING TO
REGULATION OF MASSAGE BUSINESS AND MASSAGE
TECHNICIANS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 3, Division 35, of
the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended
by amending Section 33.3510 to read as follows:

SEC. 33.3510 MASSAGE TECHNICIAN PERMIT

.....

(b)

(12) Proof of successful completion of an
examination prepared and conducted by the Depart-
ment of Public Health of the County of San Diego
wherein the applicant is required to demonstrate
a basic knowledge of anatomy, physiology, hygiene
and manual and mechanical massage. The examina-
tion shall include both a practical demonstration
and a written test. The written test shall test
the competency and ability of the applicant to
engage in the practice of massage. In lieu of
passing the written portion of such examination,
the applicant may furnish written proof of gradua-
tion from a school or institution of learning which

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has for its purpose the teaching of the theory, method, profession or work of massage, which school requires a residence course study of not less than one hundred (100) hours to be given in not more than three (3) calendar months before the student shall be furnished with a diploma or certificate of graduation from such school or institution of learning, following the successful completion of such course of study or learning, and which school has been approved by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction pursuant to the California Education Code, Section 29025.

(5) The applicant has furnished proof of either (a) graduation from a school of massage as provided in this section and proof of successful completion of a practical proficiency examination administered by the San Diego County Health Department as provided in this section; or (b) proof of successful completion of both the practical proficiency examination and written test administered by the San Diego County Health Department as provided in this section. These requirements shall not apply to any person who had been acting or employed as a massage technician on a regular basis for three (3) years immediately preceding the date



of July 2, 1976, provided satisfactory proof
of such employment can be established.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be
in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
