AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 3, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 23.0306 [RULE II OF THE RULES OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION] RELATING TO APPLICANTS AND APPLICATIONS.

WHEREAS, City Charter Section 120, "Limitations and Credits" was amended by the passage of Proposition B in the September 20, 1977 Municipal Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, such amendment conflicted with Section 23.0306 of the San Diego Municipal Code (Rule II, Section 6, of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission); and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission, at their regularly scheduled meeting of November 3, 1977, approved a change in Civil Service Rule II, to bring it into conformance with the revised City Charter Section 120; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 118 of the City Charter, the Civil Service Commission submits to the City Council such amendments for consideration and adoption; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 3, Division 3, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 23.0306 to read as follows: -

SEC. 23.0306 VETERANS' PROVISIONS [Rule II, of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission]

(1) A veteran is defined as any person who has served on active duty in any branch of the Armed Forces

of the United States in any period of time in which a Federal conscription act was in effect and who has been honorably separated from said service; except any person who is retired on a full pension or who has been employed subsequent to discharge from such service will not be considered a veteran for purposes of this Rule.

(2) A veteran claiming preference points shall file, with his application, proof of his service in the Armed Forces of the United States and honorable separation therefrom.

(3) To claim preference points in an examination, the spouse of a totally disabled veteran or the surviving spouse of a veteran who died while in active service shall file proof of such veteran's right to preference points, marriage to the veteran and the veteran's disability or death.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

SEC. 23.0308. VETERANS' PREFERENCE (Rule II, of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission)
