AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING PROPERTY IN THE LA JOLLA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTHWEST BY VIRGINIA WAY AND TORREY PINES ROAD, ON THE NORTHEAST BY SIERRA MAR DRIVE AND HILLSIDE DRIVE, ON THE SOUTHEAST BY VIA VALVERDE AND LA JOLLA SCENIC DRIVE SOUTH, ON THE SOUTH BY NAUTILUS STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY GIRARD AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO R-1-40 ZONE AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0407 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 13294, APPROVED AUGUST 31, 1931, ORDINANCE NO. 5398 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED DECEMBER 4, 1952, ORDINANCE NO. 7344 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED FEBRUARY 14, 1957, AND ORDINANCE NO. 7670 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That property in the La Jolla Community Plan Area generally bounded on the northwest by Virginia Way and Torrey Pines Road, on the northeast by Sierra Mar Drive and Hillside Drive, on the southeast by Via Valverde and La Jolla Scenic Drive South, on the south by Nautilus Street, and on the west by Girard Avenue, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundary of the district designated "R-1-40" on Zone Map Drawing No. C-545.3 filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 763161 be, and it is hereby incorporated into R-1-40 Zone, as such zone is described and defined by-Section 101.0407 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 13294, approved August 31, 1931, Ordinance No. 5398 (new Series), adopted December 4, 1952, Ordinance No. 7344 (New Series), adopted February 14, 1957, and Ordinance No. 7670 (New Series), adopted December 3,

1957, of the ordinances of The City of San Diego, be, and they are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, and no building permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefor was made prior to the date of adoption of this ordinance.
