

ORDINANCE NO. 12328

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING PROPERTY IN THE LA JOLLA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA GENERALLY BOUNDED ON THE NORTHWEST BY VIRGINIA WAY AND TORREY PINES ROAD, ON THE NORTHEAST BY SIERRA MAR DRIVE AND HILLSIDE DRIVE, ON THE SOUTHEAST BY VIA VALVERDE AND LA JOLLA SCENIC DRIVE SOUTH, ON THE SOUTH BY NAUTILUS STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY GIRARD AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO R-1-40 ZONE AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0407 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 13294, APPROVED AUGUST 31, 1931, ORDINANCE NO. 5398 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED DECEMBER 4, 1952, ORDINANCE NO. 7344 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED FEBRUARY 14, 1957, AND ORDINANCE NO. 7670 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED DECEMBER 3, 1957, OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INSOFAR AS THE SAME CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That property in the La Jolla Community Plan Area generally bounded on the northwest by Virginia Way and Torrey Pines Road, on the northeast by Sierra Mar Drive and Hillside Drive, on the southeast by Via Valverde and La Jolla Scenic Drive South, on the south by Nautilus Street, and on the west by Girard Avenue, in the City of San Diego, California, within the boundary of the district designated "R-1-40" on Zone Map Drawing No. C-545.3 filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 763161 be, and it is hereby incorporated into R-1-40 Zone, as such zone is described and defined by Section 101.0407 of the San Diego Municipal Code.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 13294, approved August 31, 1931, Ordinance No. 5398 (new Series), adopted December 4, 1952, Ordinance No. 7344 (New Series), adopted February 14, 1957, and Ordinance No. 7670 (New Series), adopted December 3,


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1957, of the ordinances of The City of San Diego, be, and they are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage, and no building permits for development inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be issued unless application therefor was made prior to the date of adoption of this ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 12345 (NEW SERIES) RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE POSITION OF LEGISLATIVE ANALYST AND ORDINANCE NO. 12344 (NEW SERIES) RELATING TO THE ALLOCATION OF PERSONNEL AND FUNDS FOR THAT FUNCTION.

WHEREAS, the Council introduced Ordinance No. 12345 (New Series) on February 2, 1977, amending the salary ordinance to establish the position of Legislative Analyst; and

WHEREAS, the Council subsequently introduced Ordinance No. 12344 (New Series) on that date to amend the budget for the purpose of allocating funds for the payment of the Legislative Analyst function and related personnel; and

WHEREAS, said ordinances were challenged in court as being in conflict with the provisions of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court for the State of California in the County of San Diego ruled in Case No. 826185 by judgment entered on September 12, 1977, that the action did, in fact, violate the Charter of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the court further ordered that said ordinances be rescinded; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 12345 (New Series) relating to the establishment of the position of Legislative Analyst and Ordinance No. 12344 (New Series) relating to the allocation of funds for that function and related personnel be, and they are hereby rescinded.

Section 2. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to transfer within the General Fund 100 the sum of \$129,247 from the Legislative Analyst Program Reserve 02.10 to the Unassigned Reserve 02.20.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


