WHEREAS, after due debate and deliberation, the Council enacted Ordinance No. 12142 (New Series) amending several sections of the Municipal Code relating to the Transient Occupancy Tax; and

WHEREAS, it is now deemed necessary to provide by further amendment additional clarification for the purpose of eliminating any perceived ambiguity and intra-section conflict; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 35.0113 to read as follows:

SEC. 35.0113 ACTIONS TO COLLECT

Any tax required to be paid by any transient under the provisions of this Article shall be deemed a debt owed by the transient to the City and payable through

the operator. Any such tax, collected by an operator, which has not been paid to the City, shall be deemed funds held in trust for the account of the City which are due and payable by the operator to the City pursuant to the provisions of this Article. Any person owing money to the City under the provisions of the Article shall be liable to an action brought in the name of The City of San Diego for the recovery of such amount.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirthieth day from and after its passage.
