AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATING THE TOOLEY AND 60TH STREET **MAY 23 1978**  
ANNEXATION AND GREENWOOD CEMETERY ANNEXATION INTO  
COUNCIL DISTRICT 4.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San  
Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the area designated as the TOOLEY AND  
60TH STREET ANNEXATION, which area was annexed to the City  
of San Diego by Resolution Minute Order No. 34, adopted by  
the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego  
on January 19, 1977, and the area designated as GREENWOOD  
CEMETERY ANNEXATION, which area was annexed to the City of  
San Diego by Resolution Minute Order No. 32, adopted by the  
Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego on May 11,  
1977, are hereby added to Council District 4, which district  
is shown and delineated on that certain map on file in the  
office of the City Clerk as Document No. 742458, showing the  
boundary line of said district, and which district was defined  
and which map was approved by Ordinance No. 10990 (New Series)  
of the ordinances of The City of San Diego, adopted February 6,  
1973.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in  
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


