AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONSENTING TO THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE CABLE TELE-VISION FRANCHISES HELD BY AMERICAN TELEVISION AND COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION TO A WHOLLY OWNED SUBSIDIARY OF TIME INCORPORATED.

WHEREAS, American Television and Communications Corporation is a cable television franchisee of The City of San Diego under the terms of Ordinances No. 9085 (N.S.), No. 10502 (N.S.), No. 10110 (N.S.), No. 9966 (N.S.), No. 10207 (N.S.) and No. 8926 (N.S.); and

WHEREAS, American Television and Communications Corporation

proposes to transfer the ownership of said cable television

franchises, through merger of American Television and Communications

Corporation, into a newly formed, wholly owned subsidiary of Time

Incorporated ("Time, Inc.") to be known as American Television and

Communications Corporation; and

WHEREAS, American Television and Communications Corporation has by a letter dated February 22, 1978, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 763678 requested The City of San Diego to consent to the aforementioned transfer of said franchises to Time Inc. pursuant to the provisions of Section 8 of Ordinances No. 10502 (N.S.), No. 9966 (N.S.) and No. 10110 (N.S.), and pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 of Ordinances No. 8926 (N.S.) and No. 9085 (N.S.); and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended said transfers subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That Time Inc. will provide local management of its San Diego franchises with sufficient local authority to make necessary decisions effecting the operations of the franchises in the City of San Diego, and
- (b) that Time Inc. will make those expenditures necessary to upgrade the head end facilities serving their San Diego franchises to provide an adequate signal level for Los Angeles stations carried on the systems serving those franchises, and
- (c) that Time Inc. will maintain sufficient staffing levels in their San Diego cable systems in order to respond to customer complaints within a 24-hour period, excepting only for force majeure circumstances beyond the reasonable control of Time, Inc., and
- (d) that Time Inc. will develop a customer relations program which will inform all its San Diego subscribers in a timely manner of any matters effecting their cable television rates and service, and
- (e) that Time Inc. will strictly comply with all the terms and conditions of aforementioned franchises; and WHEREAS, Time Inc. has indicated its willingness to accept the transfer of said franchises on the conditions as set forth above as evidenced by testimony on the public record in connection with the hearing at the introduction of this ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That The City of San Diego does by this ordinance consent to the transfer to Time Inc. of the franchises heretofore granted to American Television and Communications Corporation subject to all the terms and conditions contained in said Ordinances No. 9085 (N.S.), No. 10502 (N.S.), No. 10110 (N.S.), No. 9966 (N.S.), No. 10207 (N.S.) and No. 8926 (N.S.), and subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That Time Inc. will provide local management of its San Diego franchises with sufficient local authority to make necessary decisions effecting the operations of the franchises in the City of San Diego, and
- (b) that Time Inc. will make the necessary expenditures necessary to upgrade the head end facilities serving their San Diego franchises to provide an adequate signal level for Los Angeles stations carried on the systems serving those franchises, and
- (c) that Time Inc. will maintain sufficient staffing levels in their San Diego cable systems in order to respond to customer complaints within a 24-hour period, excepting only for force majeure circumstances beyond the reasonable control of Time, Inc., and
- (d) that Time Inc. will develop a customer relations program which will inform all its San Diego subscribers in a timely manner of any matters effecting their cable television rates and service, and
- (e) that Time Inc. will strictly comply with all the terms and conditions of aformentioned franchises.

Section 2. Failure by Time Inc. to strictly comply with all the terms and conditions set forth in Section 1 hereof shall be grounds for action by the City Council by ordinance to rescind the consent granted herein or to take such other action as the City Council deems appropriate and in the best interest of the franchise area subscribers, without giving rise to any liability to the City, its officers or agents for said act of rescission or for any other appropriate action taken by the City Council.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


