AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 3, DIVISION 12, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 23.1205 [RULE XI, SECTION 5 OF THE RULES OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION] RELATING TO APPEAL OF REMOVAL.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Attorney, the wording of the present rule may be subject to more than one interpretation; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment clearly gives the Civil Service Commission, in restoring a discharged employee, the authority to order any intermediate degree of discipline the Commission deems appropriate; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 118 of the City Charter, the Civil Service Commission submits to the City Council such amendments for consideration and adoption; NOW, THERE-FORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 3, Division 12, of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 23.1205 [Rule XI, Section 5 of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission] to read as follows:

SEC. 23.1205 APPEAL OF REMOVAL
[Rule XI, Section 5 of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission]

(Subsections (a), (b) and (c) remain the same).

(d) FINDINGS AND DECISIONS. The Commission shall report its findings and decisions to the appointing

authority responsible for the removal. Thereupon, said appointing authority shall make such final disposition of the matter as may be determined by the Commission. The Commission may at its discretion:

1. Notwithstanding Section 6 below, order the restoration of the employee to the position without loss of pay or with any intermediate degree of discipline during the period between the filing of the charges and a date specified in the Commission's order.

(Subsections (2.) and (3.) remain the same).

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
