**ORDINANCE NO. 12394**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 91.02.002 RELATING TO THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, AS BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:**

**Section 1. That Chapter IX, Article 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be amended by amending Section 91.02.002, to read as follows:**

**SEC. 91.02.002 SECTION 9102(a) AND SECTION 9102(b) OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AMENDED**

**Sec. 9102(a). Issuance.**  
(This section remains the same.)

**Sec. 9102(b). Expiration.** Every permit issued by the Building Official under the provisions of this Code shall expire by limitation and become null and void, if the building or work authorized by such permit is not commenced within 180 days from the date of such permit, or if the building or work authorized by such permit is suspended or abandoned at any time after the work is commenced for a period of 180 days. Before such work can be recommenced a new permit will first be obtained as to do, and the fee therefor shall be one-half the amount required for a new permit for such work, provided no changes have been made or will be made in the original plans and specifications for such work, provided that such suspension or abandonment has not exceeded one year, and provided further that no refunds have been made as authorized by Section 9102(c). Council may by resolution extend for a period of 60 days the expiration date of an outstanding building permit, if as a result of extraordinary climate situations hardship may result to the permittee.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
