AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING CERTAIN LANDS IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND NAMING SAID PARK "AVIARY PARK."

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That all that portion of Lot 100 of Miramar Ranch Unit No. 3, which is more particularly described in Attachment A hereto which is by this reference incorporated herein, is hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby named AVIARY PARK.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.




LEGAL DESCRIPTION
