purposes.

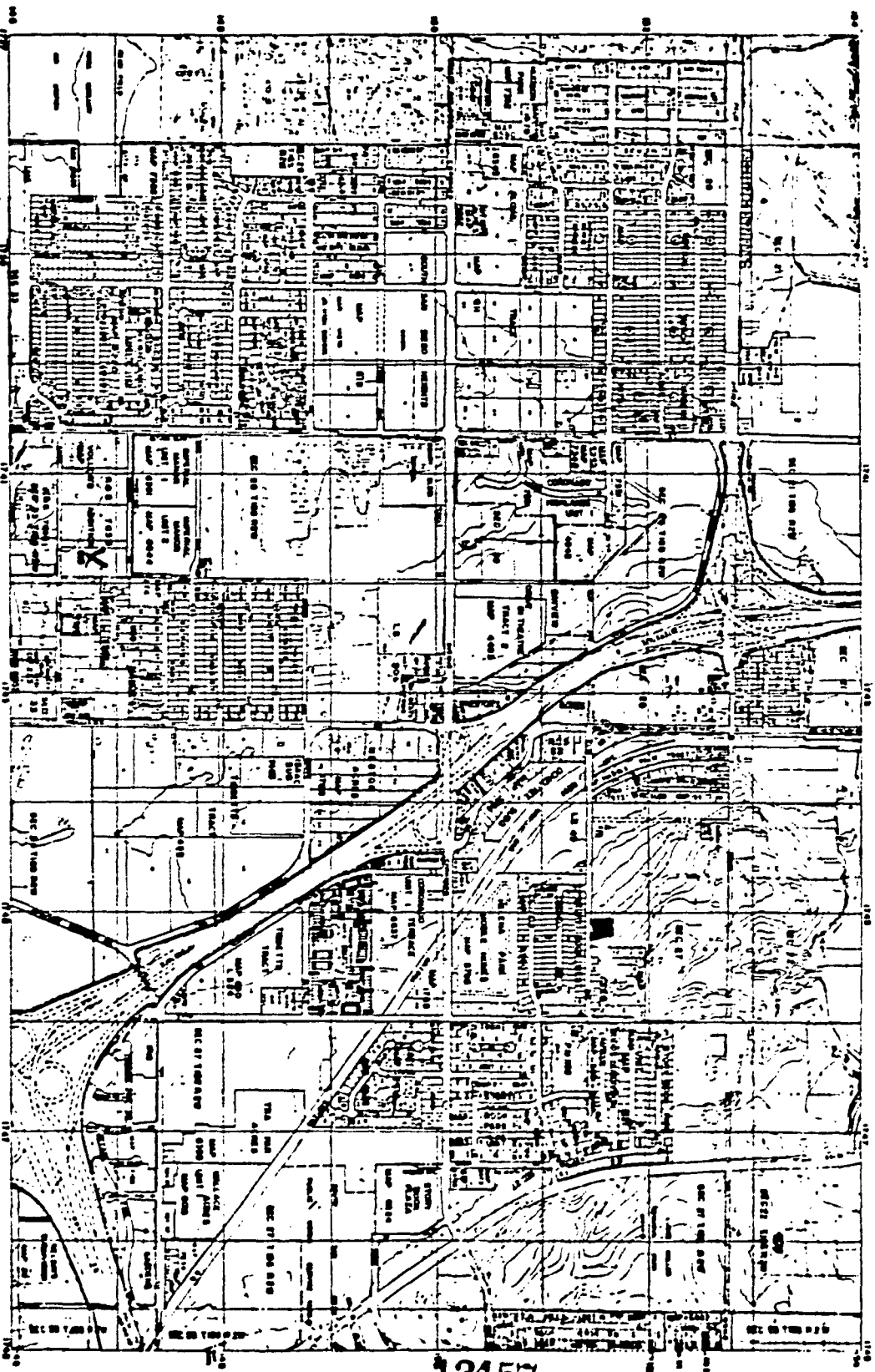
