BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 2, of the San
Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by
repealing the following section:

SEC. 32.01 ALLOCATION OF REVENUE FOR CAPITAL OUTLAY
EXPENDITURES

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

~~One-fourth of the total revenue collected from the tax imposed by this article shall be paid into the Capital-Outlay Fund and shall be used for capital-outlay expenditures provided, however, that a sufficient portion of said revenue shall be used for annual debt service of bonds issued for the purchase of Community-Concourse properties, and provided further that a maximum of one million dollars annually of said revenue may be used the next three fiscal years for replacement of fire-suppression heavy-motive equipment which has been assigned a service-life expectancy of eighteen years and provided further that, in fiscal year 1977-78, one million dollars of said revenue may be used to provide the City's contribution to the County through the Redevelopment Agency to effect, in part, the County's cost of constructing a County office building on the block bounded by First and Front and 13th and 16th Streets, respectively.~~


